The high selling bull and high selling Chiangus went to a long-time, repeat customer, Jay Hatcher of Greensboro, AL for \$5,700. This two year old bull from CK Farms of Hope Hull, AL boasted a BW EPD in the top 4% with WW & YW in the top 10%. The second high seller and the high selling Angus was selected by DeV Vaughn Farms of Deatsville, AL from \$5,200. This two year old son of SAV Net Worth 4200 was consigned by Pintlala Cattle Company of Hope Hull, AL. The high selling Simmental from Pintlala Cattle was chosen by Thomas Kirkland of Headland, AL for \$4,300. The high selling Charolais bull from Meadows Creek Farm of Columbia, AL was selected by a repeat buyer, George Hammonds of Hayneville, AL for \$4,250.

142 bulls averaged \$3,491. 24 two year old Chiangus from CK Cattle averaged \$4,029. 6 yearling Chiangus averaged \$2,733. 26 two year old Charolais from Meadows Creek Farm averaged \$3,781. One Charolais-Angus brought \$4,000. 16 yearling Charolais averaged \$2,788. 47 two year old Angus from CK & Pintlala averaged \$3,570. 21 two year old Simmental & Sim-Angus from Pintlala averaged \$3,107. Buyers were from AL, FL, GA, TN, LA, IN and MO.
