

Arcadia Black & White Bull Sale

The First Annual Arcadia Black & White Bull Sale got off to a great start as sales manager, Carl McKettrick welcomed a capacity crowd. Bidding was brisk as auctioneer Kenny Raney sold 84 two year old bulls for a total average of \$2,707. Buyers were from Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Kansas and North Carolina. Volume buyers were Brian Beville of Fort Pierce, Fla. and Ed Yarborough Ranches of Geneva, Fla.

Meadows Creek Farm from Columbia, Ala., brought 31 Charolais bulls. The final average was \$3,013. John Ward of J7 Ranch in Clewiston, Fla., purchased the high seller for \$3,700. The bull was MC Easy Duke 9116 and is a 12/5/09 son of VCR Sir Duke 199.

Twenty-seven Angus bulls commanded a \$2,441 average for Pintlala Cattle Company of Hope Hull, Ala. Cary Mike Mercer of Arcadia, Fla., owned the winning bid of \$2,900 for Lot 62. The bull was PINTLALA Bixmark 50 and is a 12/5/09 son of SAV Bismark 5682.

Twenty-six Brangus bulls averaged \$2,620. Salaco Valley Farms of Fairmount, Ga., consigned both co-high sellers. Perry Cattle of Venus, Fla., purchased Lot 118 for \$2,900. The same bid selected Lot 124 for Greg Jackson of Felda, Fla.
